

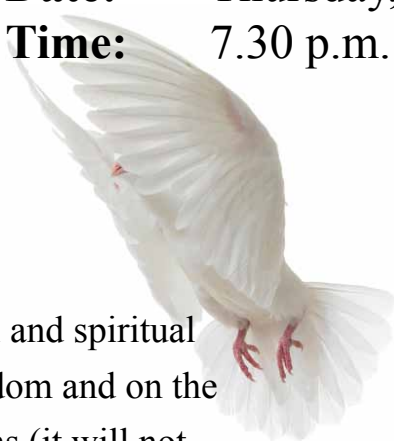
Ladislav Orsy, S.J. will give the Second Michael Hurley Memorial Lecture
